### BROKEN CHAIR, GENEVA - STUDY TOUR

The Broken Chair in Geneva is a powerful and thought-provoking sculpture that stands as a symbol of the ongoing struggle against landmines and other weapons that continue to maim and kill innocent civilians around the world. The study tour offers an life-changing experience.





Designed by the Swiss artist Daniel Berset and erected in 1997, the Broken Chair stands tall at 12 meters (39 feet) in front of the Palais des Nations, the headquarters of the United Nations Office at Geneva. The chair, with its single, twisted leg, serves as a stark reminder of the devastating impact of landmines and the urgent need for global action to address this humanitarian crisis.

The Broken Chair has become an iconic landmark in Geneva, drawing visitors from around the world to reflect on the human toll of armed conflict and the importance of disarmament and peace-building efforts. It stands as a powerful symbol of resilience, courage, and the unwavering determination to create a world free from the scourge of landmines and other indiscriminate weapons.

## HOMAGE TO MAHATMA GANDHI

#### "MY LIFE IS MY MESSAGE" | "MA VIE EST MON MESSAGE"

As part of the programme, all participants will invited to pay home to the Mahatma, MK Gandhi, the Father of the Nation of India.

Statue background: Geneva and Gandhi are both references in the search for peace amongst mankind. In the international district, next to the United Nations European headquarters, visitors can find a perfect spot to meditate in the Ariana park. Here stands the statue of India's "Father of the Nation", donated to the city in 2007 by the government of India as a token of friendship.



The bronze statue of Mahatma Gandhi was **created by Indian sculptor Gautam Pal**. The unveiling took place on November 14th, 2007 as part of celebrations marking 60 years of Indo-Swiss friendship treaty (1948-2008). It stands as a symbol of peace and non-violence that Mahatma Gandhi strongly advocated for.
